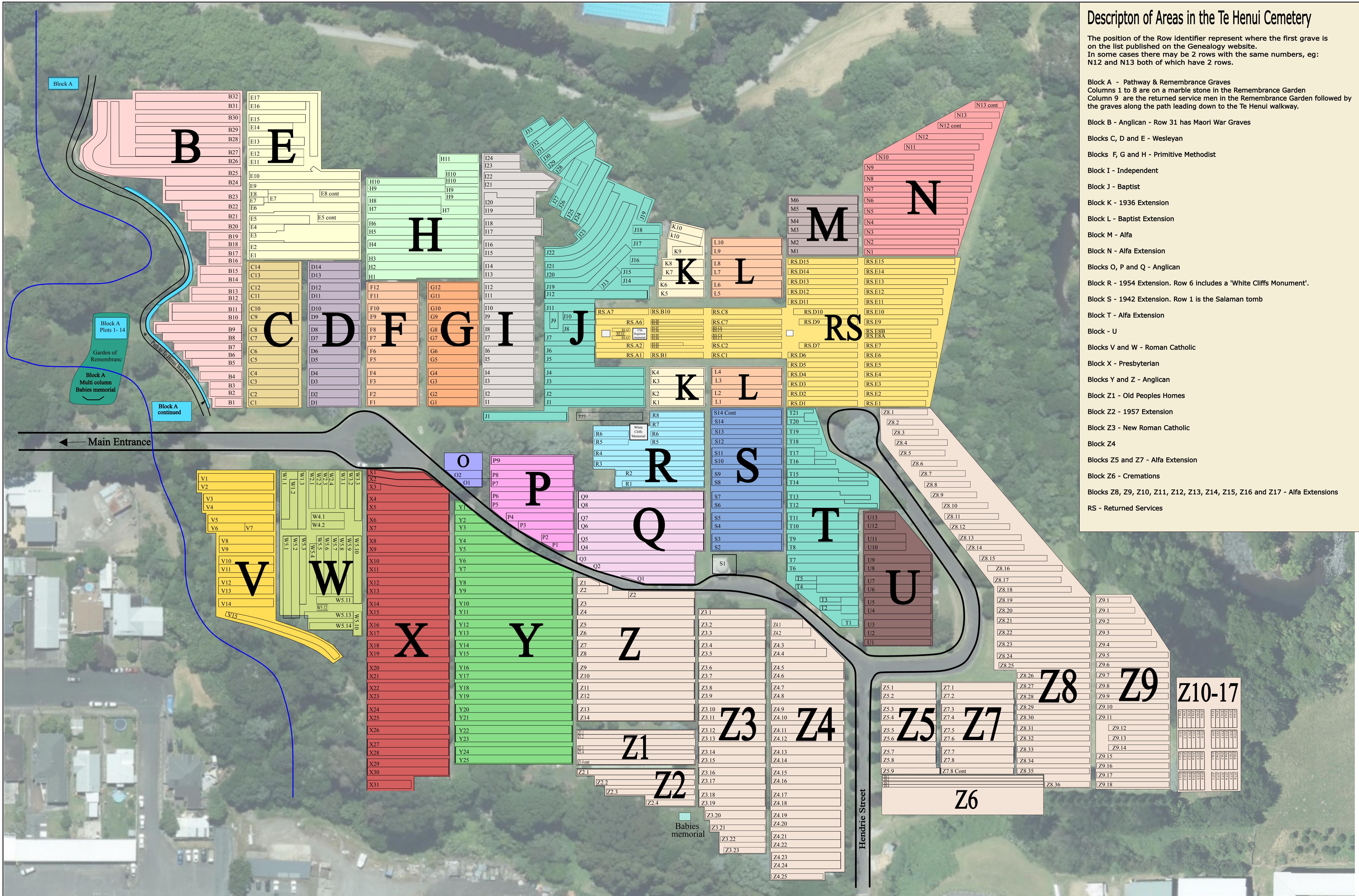


## Description of Areas in the Te Henui Cemetery

The position of the Row identifier represent where the first grave is on the list published on the Genealogy website.  
In some cases there may be 2 rows with the same numbers, eg: N12 and N13 both of which have 2 rows.

- Block A - Pathway & Remembrance Graves
- Columns 1 to 8 are on a marble stone in the Remembrance Garden
- Column 9 are the returned service men in the Remembrance Garden followed by the graves along the path leading down to the Te Henui walkway.
- Block B - Anglican - Row 31 has Maori War Graves
- Blocks C, D and E - Wesleyan
- Blocks F, G and H - Primitive Methodist
- Block I - Independent
- Block J - Baptist
- Block K - 1936 Extension
- Block L - Baptist Extension
- Block M - Alfa
- Block N - Alfa Extension
- Blocks O, P and Q - Anglican
- Block R - 1954 Extension. Row 6 includes a 'White Cliffs Monument'.
- Block S - 1942 Extension. Row 1 is the Salaman tomb
- Block T - Alfa Extension
- Block - U
- Blocks V and W - Roman Catholic
- Block X - Presbyterian
- Blocks Y and Z - Anglican
- Block Z1 - Old Peoples Homes
- Block Z2 - 1957 Extension
- Block Z3 - New Roman Catholic
- Block Z4
- Blocks Z5 and Z7 - Alfa Extension
- Block Z6 - Cremations
- Blocks Z8, Z9, Z10, Z11, Z12, Z13, Z14, Z15, Z16 and Z17 - Alfa Extensions
- RS - Returned Services
